News You Can Use...

Important Update Regarding Our Meal Program

Due to recent changes in reimbursement policies from the York County Area Agency on Aging (YCAAA), the Stewartstown Senior Center will be updating how meals are served. Beginning July 1, 2026, full funding will only be provided for congregate (in-person) meals, and we have been informed there is a strong possibility that the To-Go meal option may be eliminated entirely by the end of this year.

To help prepare for these changes and ensure we can continue serving nutritious meals to our community, we will begin gradually phasing in these adjustments over the next couple of months for those currently receiving To-Go meals.

We warmly encourage all members to join us in the dining room and enjoy meals together by going through the meal line. One of the greatest benefits of our meal program is the opportunity for fellowship, conversation, and connection with others in our community.

If you are unable to finish your meal, you are welcome to take your leftovers home. We encourage members to bring reusable containers whenever possible to help us conserve our supply of disposable containers during this transition, though containers will still be available if needed.

We truly look forward to seeing more of you in the dining room and spending time together during lunch each day. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to stop by the Director's office at any time. We are happy to talk through the changes and help in any way we can.

Thank you for your understanding, patience, and continued support of the Stewartstown Senior Center. Please know that our goal remains the same – making sure our seniors continue to receive a daily meal in a welcoming and caring environment.
